Water & Sewer Billing

Before you move to the City of Long Lake, please call City Hall at 952.473.6961 for a meter reading to be taken at your new address.

Recycling, water/sewer and storm water utility are billed together on a quarterly basis. Payments may be made in person at City Hall, 450 Virginia Avenue; or may be mailed to City of Long Lake, Attn: Utility Billing, PO Box 606, Long Lake, MN 55356. The City has a drop box at City Hall for utility payments for your added convenience.

Use Less, Save More!

CenterPoint Energy offers the following tips for water conservation:

- Install water-flow restrictors in showerheads and faucets.
- Repair leaky faucets. A leak that fills a coffee cup in 10 minutes wastes 3,280 gallons of water a year!
- Run washing machines and clothes dryers with full loads only.
- Replace old, outdated appliances with high efficiency models.

Stormwater Utility

The City Council has adopted a stormwater utility plan that took effect January 1, 2000. Residential and business informational meetings were held in June / July 1999 to discuss the creation of the utility and to answer questions. A stormwater utility is a method of financing the administration, planning, implementation and maintenance of the City's stormwater drainage and ponding systems. The utility is a "user fee" that applies to all developed parcels in the City. The fee is based upon how much rainfall runs into the sewer system rather than soaking into the ground. The utility is seen as the fairest way to allocate cost because it is based on land use and runoff produced, as opposed to property taxes or property values.
